In addition to his work in the marching arts, Connor is active as a film composer. Since 2020, he has written original music for several short films, collaborating with a variety of student and independent filmmakers. In 2025, he and his wife co-composed the score for the feature-length film *Sugarcane*, marking his largest film project to date.

He holds a Bachelor of Music in Commercial Music (Film Scoring) from Liberty University.
